





The Building Better Opportunities programme, which is funded by the Big Lottery Fund and European Social Fund, has awarded £2.3m to Business Enterprise Support, who will work with 17 partners across the south of the County. The project, which began in January 2017, aims to help those who experience multiple barriers to work in finding a job or in being better placed to look for work.

The three year project will focus on key groups who typically find they have multiple problems to overcome in finding suitable employment. It will tackle the barriers that prevent these groups of people from accessing support with more opportunities for education and training, improved health and wellbeing services, better financial help and new programmes to build people's confidence.

Support will be provided to help people build self-confidence and develop or acquire new skills in key areas where they might be experiencing difficulties
