


Building Better Opportunities Programme

"This Girl Can" project—evaluation report

Groove Academy and the Northfield Centre were successful in securing funding to run a programme targeting Mum's with young children who do less than 30 minutes physical exercise per week.

The programme ran for 10 weeks from May to the end of school term and had great attendance from Mum's with children in the classes and not. It was run as taster sessions for Mum's to try different aerobic and dance classes. They were taught Zumba, Salsa, TAPfit, Rock n Roll and even had a Spice Girls Medley choreographed for them. The fun and laughter only grew as the weeks went on and result in a couple of the women taking up regular weekly classes as a result.

Comments include;

'This is like guilt free time for me as my daughter is in the Mini Groovers class whilst I am joining in this class'. 'I would never of had the confidence to come to a Zumba class on my own. I can't believe how much I have enjoyed the experience!'

Building Better Opportunities

The Building Better Opportunities (BBO) programme funded by Big Lottery Fund and European Social Fund appointed a new BBO Community Engagement and Volunteer Work Coordinator, Tracey Gould who started on 12th June.

The BBO programme aims to address individual's multiple problems to overcome to find suitable employment opportunities tackling barriers. Tracey has over the last few months found that potential participants have a multiple complex needs and issues to address and she is providing support in various ways to address the issues including basic I.T on 1-2-1 basis and has referred clients to partners i.e. CAB.

Since Tracev started, we have appointed seven new BBO participants to the programme predominately by selfreferrals or via one of our Northfield The participants will partners. be volunteering in Northfield Village Community Hub and with other partners including Upper Moreton Farm, Wrekin Housing Trust and Elmwood Choices. The volunteering they are engaged in includes organising events, reception work and café duties.

Tracey has made links with Support Staffordshire, SCVYS, Citizen Advice Bureau, Elmwood, Limewood, Choice Housing, Screwfix and many more. Other success stories for BBO Participants included:

One participant, who was self-referred to the programme, long term wants to secure a paid part time job in an administrative role. He has complex health needs and is at present enjoying volunteering at Upper Moreton Farm in their office and is also taking part on their 10 week BBO programme. He is already showing an increase in self confidence, gaining new skills and will make significant health and well-being improvements.

A link she has made is with Screwfix Distribution centre in Stafford with the aim of developing a partnership to support potential participants in to work. We have recently been awarded £198 through their small grants programme and will be delivering two events that will benefit the community.

An issues that seems to be ongoing for Northfield is the litter problem so FUSE has been given the opportunity to apply for Screwfix Foundations grant of funds between $\pounds 2,000 - \pounds 5,000$.

Over the last few months Abi has organised Litter Picking events working in partnership with Stafford Borough Council, Street Scene, Limewood and Aspire and have collected significant amounts of not just general waste but rubbish that included McDonalds and Subway wrappers, and Alcohol bottles and cans.
